Castrol llocut<sup>™</sup> 430 (previously called Castrol Universol Oil<sup>™</sup> 430) is a chorinated, heavy-metal free, multi-purpose neat cutting oil. Formulated from highly refined base oils, it can also be used as a slideway lubricant.

## **Application**

llocut 430 is designed for general machining of ferrous as well as non-ferrous materials. It does not contain active sulphur and is hence compatible with yellow metals as well.
