

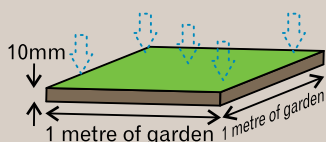
Rainwater

Rain gauges provide the ability to determine how much extra water a garden actually needs to supplement natural rainfall and avoid overwatering.

Looking at nature as a guide, 10mm of rainfall is considered good for the garden in most areas. Rainfall of 10mm is the same as 10 litres of water spread evenly over a square metre of garden.



The table below shows how much water to use on various areas to equal 10mm of rainfall.



Area	1m ²	2m ²	5m ²	10m ²	20m ²
Litres	10	20	50	100	200
